Education for Ministry, often referred to as "EFM," is a four-year course designed to help lay people develop an understanding of their faith through study of the Old and New Testament, Anglican and Christian history, and contemporary theology.

You don't have to be a scholar to study EFM, nor do you have to be a Bible expert. You simply have to want to be an inquiring soul who wishes to expand one's knowledge of how we got to where we are and who we are!

The course is written by the University of the South in Sewanee, TN. The material encourages lively discussions in our groups as we explore the Bible and the growth of the church throughout history. Yes, there is a bit of reading! Each lesson will most likely take up 2-3 hours of reading each week. The good news is that there are no tests! We encourage everyone to keep up with the readings when there are times you will miss class.

### **Sacred Conversations 2010**

We are proud to announce NPR Religion Correspondent and award-winning author, **Barbara Bradley Hagerty** as our 2010 Sacred Conversations guest speaker.



Religion Correspondent for National Public Radio since 2003, Barbara Bradley Hagerty has written a book, *Fingerprints of God: The Search for Science of Spirituality*, in which she tackles questions like: Why are some people more spiritual than others? Is there a God gene? Is there a God spot in the brain? Are we hard-wired to connect with God? Can we train ourselves to access another, spiritual realm? Is there life after death? And for that matter, is there any evidence for God at all?

Mrs. Hagerty's presentations will focus on her studies regarding the science of spirituality and her own personal spiritual journey.

Barbara Bradley Hagerty won the Religion Newswriters Award and the 2009 Gracie Award for Women in Radio and Television for her religion reporting at NPR. Formerly NPR's Justice Department correspondent, she was part of the team that won both the Peabody and Overseas Press Club awards in 2001. She is the recipient of the Templeton-Cambridge Journalism Fellowship in Science and Religion, and a Knight Fellowship at Yale Law School. Before joining NPR, Hagerty spent eleven years as a reporter at *The Christian Science Monitor*.
